PLEASE CHECK THE ELIGIBILITY RULES CAREFULLY. Read the enclosed brochure and "Information for Units Sheet", both of which give you all essential details and will be helpful for making your selection. In addition to the Eligibility Requirements, please be sure your delegate *WANTS* to attend Girls State. Program registration will be held from 1 p.m. until 3 p.m., on Sunday, June 13, 2010. The program will end at 1 p.m., Friday, June 18, 2010. Those who complete the Girls State program are given a Certificate of Completion at the final assembly, Friday morning. ***NOTE: THOSE THAT DO NOT COMPLETE THE GIRLS STATE PROGRAM WILL NOT RECEIVE A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION, AND CANNOT LIST IT ON THEIR COLLEGE AND JOB APPLICATIONS, OR RESUMES.***

The assistance of school counselors in the selection process is very valuable, but a personal interview with all candidates, by the sponsoring organization, is HIGHLY recommended. THE SELECTION OF AN ALTERNATE DELEGATE FOR EACH DELEGATE IS IMPORTANT, TOO! The enclosed Flyer, Application, and Information for Units and Girls are useful tools to attract interest, and assist with your selection. Make multiple copies and use them!

The Application(s) for delegate(s) and alternate(s) must be fully completed and legible, and returned to the Georgia Girls State Director by May 14, 2010. BE SURE EACH APPLICATION IS SIGNED BY THE PARENT/GUARDIAN, THE HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL OR COUNSELOR, AND AN AMERICAN LEGION AUXILIARY UNIT PRESIDENT/GIRLS STATE CHAIRMAN, BEFORE MAILING.

QUESTIONS THAT SHOULD BE ASKED OF CANDIDATES FOR DELEGATES AND ALTERNATES TO GEORGIA GIRLS STATE

- 1 - Do you know anything about the American Legion Auxiliary? (Explain the purpose of our organization)
- 2 - Have you any knowledge as to what the program of Girls State is about? (If none, inform them)
- 3 - Unless sickness or any other emergency existed, are you willing to spend the entire week at Girls State June 13 until June 18 at approximately 1:00 P.M.? (If no, this would disqualify candidates, as they must stay until the entire program is completed)
- 4 - If you were selected to attend the American Legion Auxiliary Girls Nation program in July, would your parents object to you flying/traveling to Washington, D.C. alone?
- 5 - If you are employed or expect to be this summer, would you be able to make arrangements for time off from June 13 – June 18? (This answer must be yes to be considered)
- 6 - What do you feel are the qualifications of a Good Citizen?
- 7 - Will you salute the flag and participate in nondenominational prayer? (The answer to this should be yes and explain it if the candidates do not understand)
- 8 - Do you have any health issues or any other disabilities that might keep you from participating fully? If so what are they? (If the candidate is picked and needs special accommodations the Director needs to be notified immediately)
- 9 - Do you have any experience in Student Government? (Yes to this would be helpful to the candidate)
- 10 - Have you been involved in debating or oratorical contests? (Yes to this would also indicate a good candidate.)
- 11 - Have you been involved in any way helping to campaign for any elected officials? (Yes to this would also indicate a good candidate.)
- 12 - Why would you like to attend the American Legion Auxiliary Girls State Program? (This is important in making your selection)

After your selection of delegates and alternates has been made, suggest to each of them that it would be beneficial to them to visit or call some of the elected officials in their area to tell them of their being selected to attend Girls State, sponsored by the American Legion Auxiliary. They could ask them about their duties and responsibilities of the various elected and appointed positions and how to present a bill or resolution. Have them inquire about current issues within their community, County or at the State level. This would give them insight as to what to expect during their week at Girls State.

INFORMATION FOR UNITS: June 13 – 18, 2010

SPONSORSHIP:

- Girls will be accepted for enrollment when sponsored directly by a unit of the American Legion Auxiliary or approved by a unit for sponsorship by another organization.
- Every unit of the American Legion Auxiliary in Georgia is urged to sponsor one or more citizens.
- It is expected that most of the citizens will be sponsored by units. However, sponsorship of some citizens by civic, fraternal, and patriotic organizations is highly encouraged, provided the citizens are enrolled through a local unit.
- Any organization wishing to sponsor one or more citizens should contact the president or Girls State Chairman of the unit.
- Likewise, units are encouraged to contact community organizations most likely to sponsor a citizen.
- **The fee shall not be paid by citizens, parents or any family member of a citizen.**
- All organizations paying citizens' registration fees will be listed as sponsors, and they will receive recognition for full participation in the program.
- All citizens sponsored by organizations other than units will be selected in the same manner as those sponsored by Auxiliary units.
- Enrollment is limited. Therefore, Auxiliary units and other organizations desiring to sponsor citizens should make plans early to do so, sending fees at the earliest convenient date.

SELECTION OF GIRLS:

- It is recommended that selection of girls be made by a committee, consisting of the high school principal or counselor, unit president and the Girls State chairman, in addition to the head of any other organization sponsoring the citizens.
- Girls State is intended for the most outstanding girls, from the standpoint of leadership, character, and scholarship in the high schools.
- Only those girls who will enthusiastically devote their **FULL TIME** to increasing their knowledge, while at the same time advancing the whole Girls State Program, should be chosen.

REGISTRATION FEES:

- **The registration fee of \$200 is to be paid to the Department by April 9, 2010. APPLICATIONS are due by May 14th.**
- **The fee does Not Include Spending Money.**
- Substitutions (Alternates) accepted up to the last minute with appropriate approval from the Director.
- There will be NO refunds on Girls State Registration Fees.
- If you need a substitute (alternate), contact the Director.

INFORMATION PACKETS:

- **Once the girls' applications have been received, an information packet will be mailed to each girl and a confirmation email will be sent to all units and each girl who submit an email address.**
- This Packet Includes Very Urgent Information, forms, complete instructions on rules and regulations, general information, what to bring from home and other facts which citizens should know before leaving

home for Girls State. The packet includes Forms for Medical Examination, Parents Waiver, Key Agreement, Scholarship Information and the Girls State Pledge. The packets may be downloaded from the Girls State website at <http://www.georgiagirlsstate.org/forms.htm>. (These Must Be Turned In During Registration On Sunday.)

- Do Not Delay in sending in their applications. Delays cause girls representing your unit to start the week behind.
- The forms (**especially the medical forms**) must be filled out in a timely manner.
- The Girls may submit a bill for debate. Girls will need adequate time for preparation of their bill.
- If the Girls Have Not Received their Packet By May 24th, Please Contact Us At The Numbers Or The Email Addresses Listed Below.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:

- Citizens must report to Kennedy Hall on the campus of Georgia Southern University between 1:00 and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 13 and they will depart on Friday, June 18 at 1:00 PM.
- **LUNCH will Not** be provided on **Sunday**; arrangements must be made prior to arriving at Girls State.
- **Once the citizen has registered, they are not allowed to leave to eat lunch. Make sure the citizens have eaten before arriving on campus.**
- Inauguration and Graduation will be June 18, 2010 at 8:15 AM. Doors open for guests at 8:00.
- Units sponsoring the citizens are responsible for providing transportation to Girls State and back home.

ORIENTATION

- Have an orientation or have the girls attend a district or another unit's orientation!!!

GIRLS STATE STORE:

- Girls are allowed to shop during free time. We have Girls State items available for purchase. The girls will want to bring money from home to buy Girls State items and snacks.

WITHDRAWALS:

- If a girl notifies you they will be unable to attend, notify the Assistant Director, Deana Rowe at the email or cell phone listed below ASAP. Notifications are encouraged through Sunday, June 13, 2010, 5:00PM. We call all girls who do not show for safety reasons; this will prevent unnecessary calls to parents.

GIRLS NATION:

- Two outstanding citizens of the American Legion Auxiliary Georgia Girls State session will be selected by delegates and staff to attend Girls Nation.
- The Girls Nation session will be held at the National 4-H Center, Chevy Chase, MD, July 17 - 24, 2010.
- All expenses of the two citizens will be paid from the Girls State Fund.
