# Congratulations on being chosen to attend Georgia Girls State!

Report to Georgia Hall on the campus of Valdosta State University, Valdosta, GA, between 1:00 and 3:30 on Sunday June 9, 2024. Make arrangements to depart on Friday, June 14, 2024 by 1:00 PM. Please make sure that you have had lunch before you register. Once you have registered, you may not leave the campus. Our first meal is Sunday dinner at 5:30 PM.

**Before Girls State**: The 2024 Girls State Application will be a fully online application. It will be available starting March 1, 2024. You should receive the link to the application on an email.

Limit your bill to one sheet.

Do not bring campaign materials or any means to make them other than pens, pencils and markers. To keep campaigning equal for all delegates, you will not be allowed to bring materials from home. You will only be able to use paper that Girls State provides. Do not bring a laptop computer or expensive jewelry. You may bring a cell phone but cell phones may only be used during free time. The use of phones for talking and/or text messaging during any meeting or assembly will not be tolerated. It can be used for notes.

#### **Talent Show**

Girls State will have a talent show on Thursday evening. If you are interested, please bring equipment, musical instruments, music, etc. You must sign up by Tuesday at Girls State if you plan to try out for participation. Microphone and computer provided on stage. No visitors allowed.

#### Girls State House and Senate

Much of your time during the week will be spent in the House and Senate. You will be randomly assigned as a Senator or Representative. You should conduct yourself and present yourself as a young senator or representative. During the sessions, you will debate bills written by you or other Girls State Citizens. You are invited to submit one bill of statewide significance (No federal issues.) In order for your bill to be considered, you must bring 200 copies to be turned in to the government staff during registration on June 9. Sample bills and a form upon which to write your bill is enclosed. You can use it as a guide or write you bill on it.

#### **Driving to Girls State**

You may drive to Valdosta, but as soon as you have unpacked your vehicle, you must turn in your keys and receive a parking permit. We will have designated parking for citizens of Girls State. Failure to turn in your keys and receive a parking permit can result in a parking citation.

#### **Scholarship**

Samsung Scholarship: As a delegate, you have the opportunity to apply for the Samsung American Legion Scholarship. If you are a direct descendant of a U.S. wartime veteran, you are eligible to apply. The application can be obtained from the American Legion National website. There will be a link on the Georgia Girls State website no later than February 15, 2024.

Applications must be completed on line by June 9, 2024, which is the first day of Georgia Girls State. NO Exceptions!
